

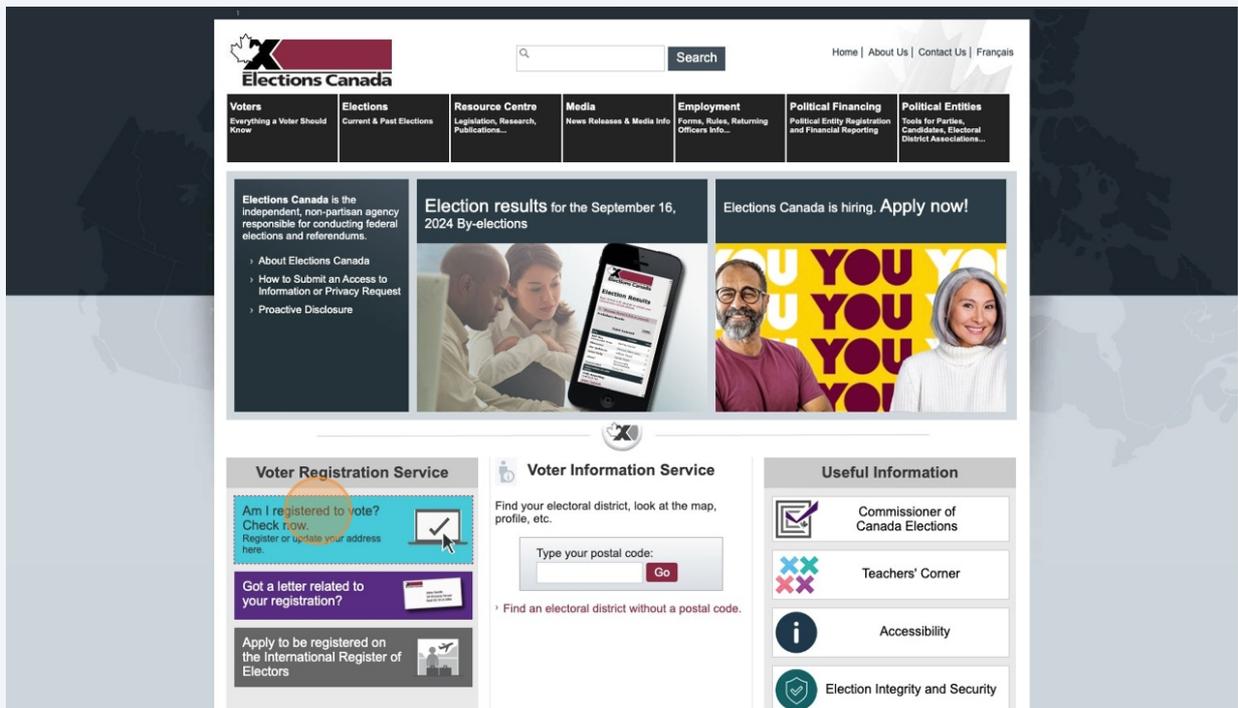
How To Check Your Voter Registration In Canada

1 Visit the Elections Canada Website:

- Open your web browser and go to <https://www.elections.ca>

2 Click on "Am I Registered to Vote?":

- In the "Voter Registration Service" section, click on the "Am I registered to vote?" link.



3 Click on "Check Your Voter Registration":

- After clicking on "Am I registered to vote?", proceed by selecting the option to "Check Your Voter Registration."

- As a security measure and for follow-up and verification, Elections Canada records the Internet Protocol (IP) address of computers that are used to access the Online Voter Registration Service.

This service is for personal use only. Please note that it is illegal under the *Canada Elections Act* to make false statements about voter registration. Those convicted face penalties.

Eligibility Criteria for Voting in Canadian Federal Elections

To be eligible to vote in a Canadian federal election, you must meet the following criteria:

1. **Canadian Citizenship:** You must be a Canadian citizen.
2. **Age Requirement:** You must be at least 18 years old on election day.

If you are a member of the Canadian Forces (CF), you can update your information online by providing your Service Number. To qualify as a CF elector, you must meet all of the following conditions:

1. You are a Canadian citizen.
2. You are at least 18 years of age on civilian polling day.
3. You are a regular or reserve member of the Canadian Armed Forces.

- To be eligible to vote in a Canadian federal election, you must be a Canadian citizen and be at least 18 years old on election day.
- To be added to the International Register of Electors, there is a separate registration process.
- Canadian Forces (CF) electors can update their information online by providing their **Service Number**.

 - You are a Canadian citizen.
 - You are at least 18 years of age on civilian polling day.

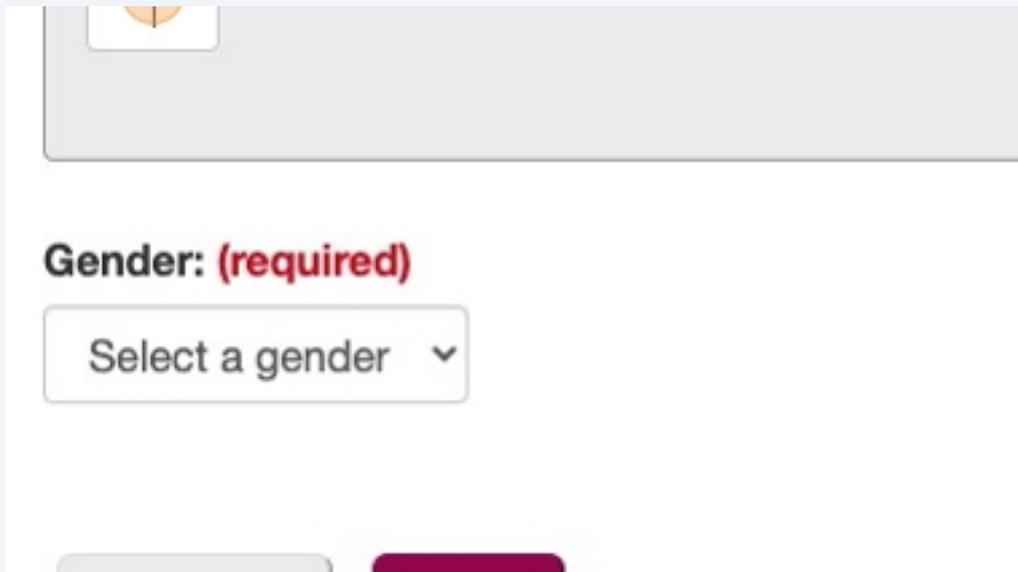

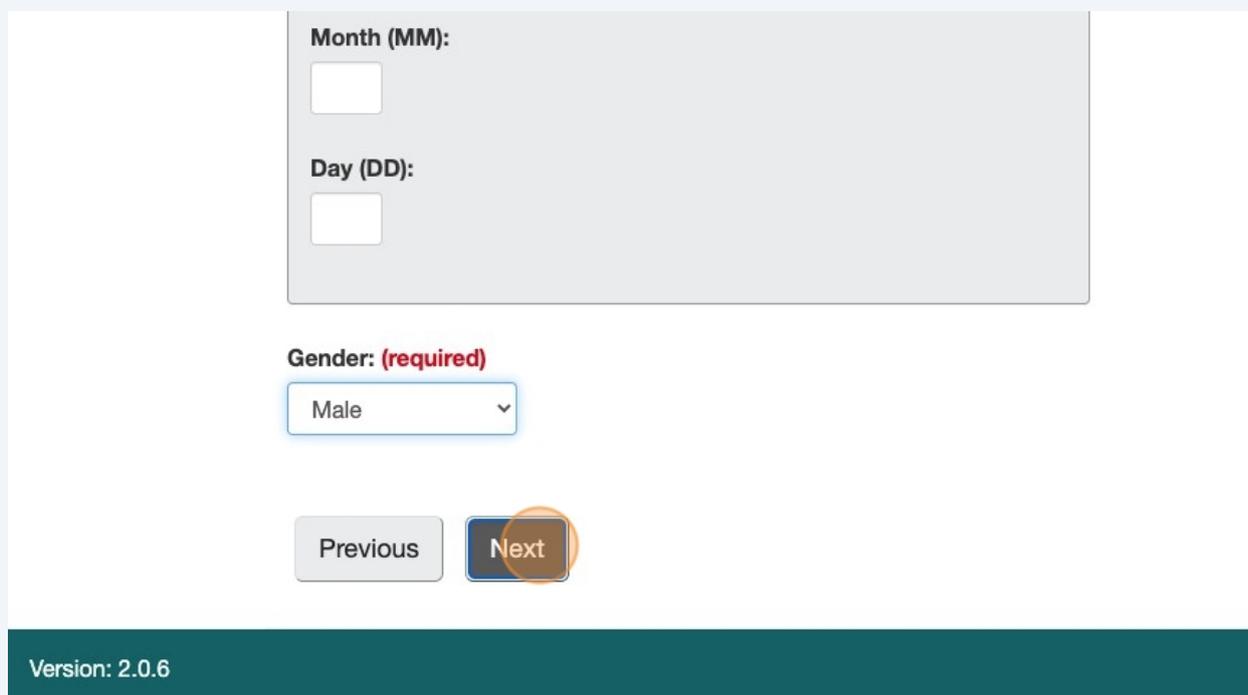
